OUR PROGRAMS

Individual Placement & Support (IPS)
Supports individuals with mental health and/or substance use challenges find and maintain meaningful work.

Vocational Peer Support
Peer Specialists use their unique set of mental health and substance use recovery experiences in combination with solid skills training to support peers along their individual recovery journey.

Chrysalis Clubhouse & Chrysalis Pops
A community-oriented program focusing on strengths and abilities to regain purpose, build relationships, and acquire tangible skills, the Clubhouse also supports Chrysalis Pops, a social enterprise, offering individuals meaningful work in growing, creating, and selling local, organic frozen fruit pops.

Certified Peer Specialist Learning Community provides technical assistance and consulting to support the integration of Certified Peer Specialist (CPS) roles across Wisconsin. Our community is made up of CPS and allies who are passionate about the peer movement.

Wings is a Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC) program that provides support to youth and young adults experiencing first-episode psychosis.
